ELIGIBILITY

Cedar Valley Hospice Care is available for those with a life-limiting illness and a prognosis of 6 months or less.



LINK Palliative Care is available to those with a chronic, life-limiting illness who need additional assistance.

TREATMENT

A care team provides pain and symptom management focused on improving a patient's comfort and quality of life rather than using life-sustaining measures.



A nurse and social worker provide care focused on using life-prolonging, curative treatments while managing a person's medications, pain and symptoms.

CARE LOCATION

Services are provided wherever a person calls home (i.e. nursing facility, hospital or private residence). Our Hospice Home is also available for short-term stays to manage acute or severe issues.



Services are provided at a person's home with the goal of helping them keep their independence and remain in their home.

PAYMENT

Covered by Medicare, Medicaid, VA and some private insurances as part of the hospice benefit. Services are available to all, regardless of ability to pay.



Covered under some private insurances or privately. As a non-profit, we provide services regardless of ability to pay.
