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Hospice Home care

Registered nurses are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week at the area's only Hospice Home. As a preferred alternative to a hospital stay, the home offers short-term inpatient and respite care. Short-term residential care is also available.

Inpatient stays provide pain and symptom management, along with skilled care for those who are imminently dying. Patients also visit the Hospice Home for respite care. This stay provides family members temporary relief from caregiving or time to attend out-of-town functions.

Features

All aspects of the Hospice Home, from a gently curved hallway to several amenities, create a comfortable, home-like atmosphere, including:

- 24-Hour nursing care
- Respite care
- Short-term residential care
- Master bedroom setting complete with en suite bathroom, table, television, dresser couch and/or lounge chairs and bay windows
- 24-Hour visitation
- Home-cooked meals for patients
- Kitchen and dining area for family use
- Guest bathroom with shower
- Patio and outdoor garden with grill
- Children's playroom
- Special therapies



Amenities

Patient rooms are furnished like personal bedrooms to create a soothing atmosphere. Large windows open the rooms to sunshine, warmth and a glimpse of nature.

The Solace Room offers a fireplace, comfortable seating and a peaceful place for families to gather for a quiet moment or relax.

A children's playroom creates a welcoming environment for young visitors, and the guest kitchen offers a place to cook a meal and enjoy coffee and fresh-baked cookies.

Paying for services
