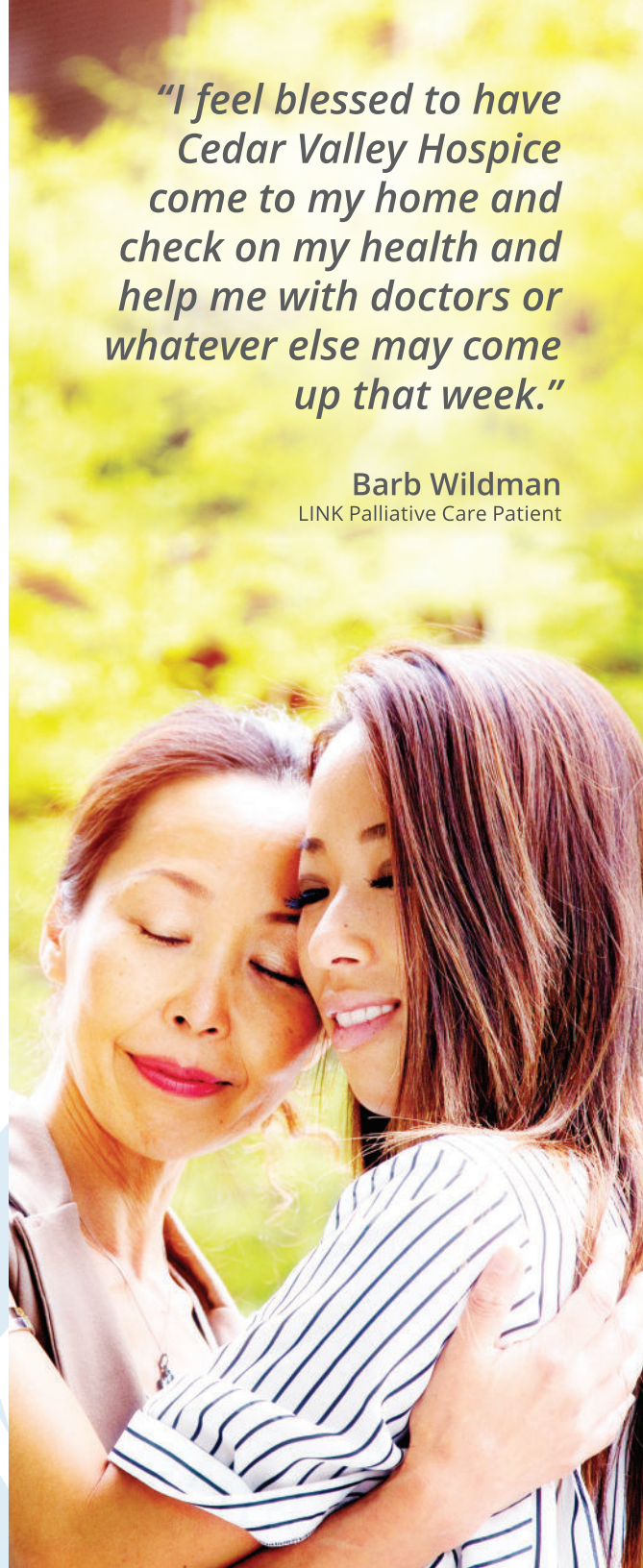

### What is LINK?

LINK is the palliative care program of Cedar Valley Hospice. It provides supportive care and case management to individuals and families facing a serious illness, who may not be eligible for, or seeking, hospice services yet.

#### Goals of LINK:

- Listen to patients and families
- Inform patients and families of resources in their communities
- Navigate the health care system
- Knowledge / educate patients and families on health care choices and treatments



### What is palliative care?

Palliative care (pronounced PAH-LEE-UH-TIVE) means to make comfortable by treating a person's symptoms. Palliative care may be offered at any time during a person's illness, and can be provided along with curative treatment. Frequency of visits is determined by the patient and family's needs in conjunction with the LINK Palliative Care team.

*ELIGIBILITY - Patients must be diagnosed with a chronic or life-limiting illness and have a physical and/or psychosocial need related to the illness.*

## The LINK team

*The LINK team consists of:*

- A nurse practitioner
- A registered nurse
- A social worker
- Patient and family
- Patient's physician

Together, the LINK team works to develop an individualized plan of care that meets the patient's physical, emotional and spiritual health needs. The plan of care may address pain or symptom management, education on diagnosis, treatment, anxiety or fear.

## Benefits of LINK

- Ongoing assessment of patient's wellness
- Expert pain and symptom control
- Emotional support
- Medication management
- Improved communication between the patient and health care providers
- Education regarding illness, treatment options
- Assistance coping with the illness
- Improved quality of life for the patient
- Support and education regarding the future, and/or hospice eligibility
- Assistance with completion of advance care plans

## When to consider LINK

It may be time to consider LINK if you or your loved one experience:

- Recurring hospital admissions or emergency department visits
- Challenges with symptom management
- Difficult decisions regarding treatment options
- Distress, anxiety or loss of hope
- A need for medication recommendations including monitoring/management
- Conflict among patient and family regarding the course of treatment

## Paying for services

A monthly fee will be determined based on household size, current income and medical expenses. If you have private insurance, we will attempt to bill your insurance company. However, you will be responsible for any remaining charges.

- For those meeting the income guidelines, the LINK team will discuss a sliding fee scale.
- You may qualify for a hardship exemption.

**NOTE: You will not be denied services based on your inability to pay.**

*Anyone can make a referral, including: health care professionals, family members, friends and clergy.*
