Grief services

Cedar Valley Hospice Grief Support Services provide counseling, support groups and education on dying, death and grief. The goal of Grief Support Services is to help family members and friends cope with the death of a loved one.

Grief services are available, free of charge, to anyone in the community grieving a death.

So many are afraid to ask for help after a loved one dies, but Cedar Valley Hospice's experts can provide support that often makes this transition easier.

We also understand that youth grieve differently than adults. The Eucalyptus Tree youth grief program helps youth ages 3-17 who are coping with the death or chronic illness of someone close to them.

Support groups

Grief support groups explore the grief process and the emotions which accompany the grief journey. These groups present important information about grief and the opportunity to share with others. Call us or visit cvhospice.org for a list of available groups.

It's important to include young people in tough conversations. This promotes trust and resilience.


