GOALS

Hospice Care focuses on providing comfort, dignity and a better quality of life.

It embraces a holistic approach that supports your physical, emotional and spiritual well being.



LINK Palliative Care focuses on easing pain and discomfort, reducing stress and guiding you through your illness and the healthcare system.

ELIGIBILITY

If you have a life-limiting illness with a prognosis of six months or less and are no longer seeking aggressive treatment, hospice is with you every step of the way.



If you're living with a serious illness at any stage, (i.e. COPD, heart disease), palliative care gives you an extra layer of support whenever you need it.

TREATMENT

Your care team manages pain and symptoms, offers guidance and provides support for you as well as your family while focusing on improving your quality of life.



A nurse and social worker will work with you to manage your medications, pain and symptoms while supporting you in continuing curative treatments as part of your care plan.

CARE LOCATION

We provide care wherever you call home (nursing facility, hospital or your own residence). Our Hospice Home is available for short stays to help manage urgent needs or for respite (to give your loved ones a break).



We provide care at your own home or an assisted living community, supporting you in maintaining your independence and staying comfortable right where you live.

PAYMENT

Your hospice care is covered by Medicare, Medicaid, VA and most private insurance plans as part of the hospice benefit.



Your care is covered under some private insurance plans or through self-pay.

As a non-profit, we're committed to providing hospice or palliative care services to you regardless of your ability to pay.
